Sturt Gorge Recreation Park covers 244 hectares and is bounded by Craighurn, Flagstaff Hill, Bellevue Heights and Bedford Park. Within the boundaries of the Park are areas of considerable biological, geological and historical significance.



The Gorge features beautiful open forest and woodlands, stunning native orchid displays, walking trails, steep cliffs, majestic river red gums and rocky streams.
