Working bees are automatically cancelled in the following situations: a forecast of 35°C or higher; a Total Fire Ban; a severe weather warning; a lockdown is declared.

Due to COVID19, please maintain social distancing and bring your own morning tea unless otherwise advised. Your working bee leader can provide you with tools and personal protective equipment. A First Aid kit is always taken out to working bees, and we ask that you keep your First Aid booklet up to date and in your backpack. Please let your working bee leader know if you need a First Aid booklet.

We encourage you to wear long pants, long sleeves, sturdy shoes and sun protection to protect yourself against scratches, sunburn, ants and snakes. Work priorities may change on the day if conditions are unsafe. Please remember to sign on when you arrive and sign off before you leave the site.
