\*\* Detailed directions for meeting point on Blackwood Park Boulevard, Craighburn Farm - From Coromandel Parade turn into Blackwood Park at the Grand Boulevard roundabout. Turn left at the next roundabout into Ferguson Avenue, and left again at the next roundabout into Blackwood Park Boulevard. Drive past the Meridian Sales Office for 200m and turn left opposite the playground. Drive slowly through pinch point and park before/after you reach the pumping station, depending on work site location. This is a new subdivision so not all streets currently show up on devices.

All Biodiversity and Trails working bees are scheduled for 3 hours but you are welcome to arrive or leave earlier – always work to suit your health. Planting events may vary in duration depending on how many attendees there are. Meetings tend to go for 1.5-2 hours.

Working bees are cancelled if the forecast is above 35°C, or if there is a Total Fire Ban or severe weather warning such as high winds or hail.

Due to COVID19, please maintain social distancing and bring your own morning tea, unless otherwise advised. Your working bee coordinator can provide you with tools and personal protective equipment. We encourage you to wear long pants, long sleeves, sturdy shoes and sun protection to protect yourself against scratches, cold or sunburn. Work priorities may change on the day if conditions are unsafe. Please remember to sign on, and sign off when you leave. Any additional working bees will be promoted via the email list.
